Reunion on the greens helps long-haulers

After two years away, it was an amazing reunion on the greens! Incredible sponsors and participants came together on a beautiful June day and hit the links in support of the continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic at MHC.

More than 12,000 post-COVID patients in Manitoba have experienced a condition known as long-haul COVID-19. Two rehabilitation programs at MHC—Easy Street and MHC for Lungs—are working together to bring these patients a better quality of life, and the proceeds from this year's tournament directly supported equipment purchases for these programs.

Respiratory therapists at MHC for Lungs help long-haul COVID-19 patients who experience severe shortness of breath, even at rest. After an eight-week program at MHC for Lungs, long-haul patients are often ready to move on to Easy Street programming

where physiotherapists build on the MHC for Lungs exercises and therapy, reassessing patients and modifying their program as they progress. Occupational therapists use strategies to improve cognition and memory.

Long-haul COVID patient Frank Adam was diagnosed with COVID-19 in October 2020 and still experiences severe fatigue and issues with breathing, memory and concentration. Frank was a professional photographer before COVID-19 hit. He just finished the MHC for Lungs program and is starting up with Easy Street. Although he's had some physical strength improvement, severe fatigue is still a big challenge.

He's grateful for the MHC rehabilitation programming, and the donors that support it, saying it's "one of the things, besides my family, that's keeping me positive."



INVISION was incredible

After two years of sparse social calendars, how wonderful it was to spend an incredible evening together celebrating and supporting MHC's Eye Care Centre of Excellence!

Together, with a sold-out crowd in attendance, we ensured those on the front lines are able to continue enhancing patient experiences by incorporating the latest, most advanced technology.

Donors contributing to the Fund-a-Need initiative during the Foundation's InVision event have helped ensure Manitobans receive the best eye care possible at Misericordia with the purchase of a new slit lamp camera and a portable B-Scan for the Ophthalmology team.

This equipment is vital to quality eye care, especially in a high-volume clinic. The newest slit lamp camera allows doctors to share high-resolution 3D digital photos of the eye with specialists to help the team triage emergency eye issues and allow the correct treatment to begin sooner. The portable B-Scan is a powerful and portable diagnostic tool that takes critical images for ophthalmologists wherever they may find themselves on site.

Dr. John van der Zweep, head of Ophthalmology, says the whole team is so grateful to donors.

“You’re truly making a tremendous impact on the level of care we are able to offer. Your support of these items ensures we are always able to offer exceptional and innovative care to all Manitobans. Thank you.”



Simple connections make a world of difference

MHC staff live our mission of caring for our community, each and every day. Nowhere is this more visible than in our Transitional Care Unit (TCU), which cares for many who may be especially marginalized or in vulnerable situations. This 111-bed unit serves patients who require complex social and medical support for a short time as they transition out of MHC and back home, or to community services, a personal care home, or a hospice.

TCU patients often come to MHC from another facility, no longer requiring the level of care which is provided in an acute-care hospital. This is an important step in freeing up resources in acute-care settings, which the pandemic has shown us is a crucial step in providing all Manitobans with the best care possible, as close to home as possible. During the TCU short-term stay – typically 30 to 90 days – patients receive on-going treatment while being assessed to determine the best setting for them in the future.



TCU takes a holistic approach to healing, and provides services as far-reaching as dietitians, occupational and physical therapists, recreation facilitators and therapists, social workers, peer support, and spiritual-health providers. We have seen time and again that offering a full complement of support during this crucial transition time can lessen—and at times even eliminate—the need for future health services.

Jackie Heidinger has been making important connections with TCU patients at MHC, and she will be making more thanks to the support of donors like you. Jackie is the Peer Connections Manitoba (PCM) peer support worker who has been lending her ear and open heart to TCU patients since January 2022 as part of a pilot project.

“The program is a success, and we are happy to be able to continue the partnership going forward,” says Jennifer Klos, MHC spiritual health and therapeutic services manager, adding that the continuation of the program has only been made possible thanks to the generosity of MHC Foundation donors.

In the first two months of the program, Jackie brought her gentle spirit to find connections with more than 55 TCU patients. Jackie says she finds peer support work “personally meaningful and professionally fulfilling for me. I am thoroughly enjoying working at MHC for I have many conversations about hope and resiliency with the peers I support.”

“Navigating the health-care system can be daunting. We are so thankful for our partnership with MHC and the donors that have made this possible in helping us to overcome barriers and provide support to people at the time and place where they need it.”

All smiles

Your support helps reduce children's pain – literally!

If toddlers and preschool children have severe tooth decay in their primary teeth then their ability to eat, sleep and speak could be dramatically affected. Pediatric dental surgery provides much-needed relief from the pain that can be caused by severe tooth decay.

This year donors generously funded 20 specialty pediatric surgical instruments, designed for primary teeth.

"These instruments make the experience infinitely better," says Dr. Robert Diamond, pediatric dental surgeon. "The instruments are just perfect for tiny teeth."

This important equipment includes stainless-steel instruments which have very slim handles, allowing for greater maneuverability and increased field of view in small mouths.

An added bonus of the new pediatric dental instruments is reduced waste: MHC's medical device reprocessing department sterilizes the instruments on site!

Nearly 900 pediatric dental surgeries are performed at Misericordia Health Centre annually.
